Gerri Caruso gave the power point presentation, *General Plan Growth Scenarios*, posted on the Horizon 2035 website. A handout outlining housing units and office/industrial/commercial floor area for the Current General Plan and Possible Growth Scenario was distributed.

5) **Discussion of Growth and Change**

Chair Glaser facilitated discussion of growth and change in Sunnyvale.

6) **CAP Policy Overview**

Committee members were provided with a preliminary draft of CAP Goals, Policies and Actions for their review and feedback prior to the CAP Community Workshop scheduled for September 29<sup>th</sup>.

7) **Discussion CAP Policies**

Preliminary draft CAP policies/actions were outlined with the following goal categories:

- *Community Action* - Educate and engage Sunnyvale residents, schools, and businesses in the City's effort to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- *Energy Efficiency and Conservation* - Decrease energy consumption by \_\_\_% by improving energy efficiency and conserving energy throughout the community and City operations.
- *Renewable Energy* - Increase the amount of energy from renewable sources within the community by \_\_\_% or \_\_\_kWh.
- *Water* - Decrease Sunnyvale's per capita water consumption by \_\_\_gallons per year by 2020 in order to reduce energy consumption and conserve natural resources.
- *Landfill Waste* - Decrease the amount of waste sent to landfill by \_\_\_% by 2020 through increased recycling, composting, and materials management.
- *Open Space and Urban Forestry* - Increase the amount of open space in Sunnyvale by \_\_\_% and achieve an urban tree canopy cover of \_\_\_% by 2020 in order to improve air quality and mitigate the urban heat island effect.
- *Improved Transportation Options* - Replace \_\_\_vehicles miles per year with alternate modes by 2020 by increasing the convenience and safety of bicycling, walking and transit.
- *Optimize Vehicular Travel* - Optimize the efficiency of necessary vehicular travel within Sunnyvale to reduce fuel consumption by \_\_\_% by 2020.
- *Parking and Land Use* - Utilize land use and parking requirement to reduce the need for vehicular travel by \_\_\_% by 2020.

Vu Bang Nguyen, Land Use Program Coordinator from Urban Habitat, outlined the itinerary for the transit-oriented design tour scheduled for October 23. The tour will be a collaborative effort with the City of Sunnyvale, Urban Habitat, and Greenbelt Alliance provided at no cost to participants, and open to the public.

Committee members were requested to provide their comments on CAP draft policies to Michael McCormick with PMC by Monday, September 20 for consideration at the upcoming CAP Community Workshop on September 29.
