Committee members that participated in the Joint Study Session on October 26 with City Council, Planning Commission and Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee provided feedback. Project Lead, Gerri Caruso provided an overview of next steps and informed the Committee that Council has not extended the deadline for project completion beyond Fall 2011.

Staff presented visual images of possible forms via power point and posters, such as mixed use with two-story over residential, mixed use with four-story over residential, “wedding cake” style set-backs, nine-story commercial/office, etc. Committee members were provided with two handouts:

- Land Use Areas/Description/Primary Change Areas
