COMMUNITY WORKSHOP PLANNED FOR SUNNYVALE'S FIRST CLIMATE ACTION PLAN

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Horizon 2035 is an important combination of two projects under way at the City to address Sunnyvale's energy and water efficiency, land use, transportation and air quality. These projects are the Land Use and Transportation Element (LUTE), part of the City General Plan, and the Climate Action Plan (CAP).

The LUTE and CAP are two unique projects, but the issues they cover are related. Since both the LUTE and the CAP are being completed concurrently, the City is gathering public input on both policy documents. It is also beneficial to address both projects at the same time in an effort to make the projects as cost-efficient as possible for Sunnyvale residents.

The City needs community input on the project, and will host a community workshop to gather public comment at 7 p.m., Wednesday, September 29. The meeting will be held in the Sunnyvale City Council Chambers, 456 W. Olive Ave.
