

Corte Madera General Plan Update
Meadow Creek Station Meeting Notes for September 9, 2002

The following comments were received:

- Upper San Clemente Creek should be considered in the General Plan as a wetland and for habitat restoration.
- Need sufficient commitment from the Town regarding plans in the new General Plan to maintain tidal flows throughout the year.
Recognize as “historic tidal wetlands.”
- No real transit service is provided to this portion of the Town
- The open space/park site in the Meadow Creek development is paid for and maintained by the Home Owner’s Association, but the public uses it.
Perhaps the Town can assist.
- Landscaping by Highway 101 on Koch Road up to Paradise Drive needs improvement by Caltrans; address this in the General Plan.
- Paradise Wine & Liquor needs aesthetic improvements.
- Recreational Facilities
East side residents may not use west side facilities.
Skate parks present only a limited range for public use but utilize significant public funds.
